
REBECCA NIEDERLANDER'S hovering, animated wire works float somewhere between abstraction and representation. Her sculptures literally elevate particulars and mise-en-scene elements that often escape notice. The works' protean quality creates a fantastical sphere into which viewers can enter or onto which they can project their own discoveries and beliefs. The relationship between the wires' physical lines and their alter-ego shadows adds to the theatricality. All elements are connected, each aspect modulated by the subtle movement of the whole.



Family Tree: Stormytime, 2006 plastic insulated copper electrical wire and polycarbonate tube $67\times30\times12$ inches










Family Tree: Call and Response, 2007 plastic insulated copper electrical wire $70 \times 27 \times 25$ inches
